On 5th and 6th April i organised a 'pop-up' photography exhibition adjacent to one of the underpasses at Lawrence Hill Roundabout as one of a series of Community Activities. I exhibited 12 images home printed on my color managed Epson P900 photo-printer. The paper was Ilford Galerie pearl sized a A3+. I used the appropriate colour profile whilst printing from the Print module in Lightroom.

The images were protected in transparent poly-pockets and attached to a string system i had suspended from railings above. Clips attached the prints to the string.

On Sunday 5th April displaying the images was problematic due to residual winds from Storm David, however on Sunday 6th April the winds had ceased and the exhibition was problem free.

This was the first single exhibition I had mounted for at least a decade and I came to appreciate once more the singular pleasure of communicating my photography with others independent of a computer screen.

Recent trips to exhibitions in Paris and the UK had provoked my interest sufficiently to purchase the new printer several months ago and this was the first serious printing I had done.

As a former proficient silver printer I had intended to make silver gelatin prints to complement these colour images, even contact prints of the large format negatives I had made. Unfortunately I ran out of both time and energy, but now have a stock of Ilford Multigrade paper (RC and not fibre) available for when I choose to re-enter my darkroom.
